What medicines do we make?

We make all kinds of customised medicine.

HRT: Some are for Hormone Replacement Therapy (HRT) where we use only bio-equivalent hormones – ones with chemical structures exactly the same as the hormones our bodies produce. This is very different from the synthetic hormones used in commercially-prepared HRT.

Hospice: For hospice patients, among many other requirements we can combine multiple medications into a single convenient dosage.

Paediatric: For children who dislike the taste of some medicines, add flavours of their choice or even deliver their medications through flavoured lollipops. Or mix a slow-release system that gives two doses of medicine a day, from one capsule – eliminating their need to remember another during the day, and potential peer ridicule if it must be taken at school.

Pain: There are customised medicines for pain management – for those struggling with chronic problems like arthritis, migraines and nerve and muscle pain.

Dosages: All these medicines can be produced in various forms. There are standard tablets and capsules. But if you have difficulty swallowing, your medicine can be prepared in a solution; or other delivery systems such as troches or lozenges dissolved in the mouth; lollipops for the kids; transdermal gels, creams and ointments; and suppositories to name a few – all depending on your own special needs, and your doctor's recommendations.

Veterinary: We can also prepare special veterinary medicines.



Is tailor-made better than commercial medicine?

Not necessarily – and anyway, not everyone needs tailor-made medicine.

But because it's individualised, rather than mass-produced, it meets the special needs your doctor has identified for you – in strength and dosage form.

As your compounding pharmacist, we draw on our professional training and work with your doctor to get the best outcome for you.
